Introduction

BACK GROUND

In 2014 I started developing my vision of setting up an NGO that would comprise of the following departments;

- Health
- Animal production
- Crop production
- SACCO
- Fisheries
- Poultry

The organization is registered both at district and international level with Uganda Registration Service Burial (URSB).

HEALTH

We started by setting up a health facility which has now been upgraded to a Health Centre 111 level offering the following services;

- Antenatal care
- Maternity service
- Laboratory service
- Outpatient and inpatient services

- Immunization
- Community health education
- Dental health.

We partner with Infectious Disease Institute (IDI) in HIV / AIDS, counseling, testing and enrolment of HIV positive clients on ARVs.

PIGGERY DEMONSTRATION SITE

We started a piggery project with 10 pigs which produced more and later with started using artificial insemination that was conducted by Bukenya who was working under Kabwangu Farmers Association. After we mentioned the off springs of the insemination pigs which showed good quality compared to our pigs.

We have also set up an inorganic, microorganism (IMO structures) which is cost effective both in construction and maintenance using our local materials.

We are now using nipples in supplying water for drinking to our pigs, this ensures that pigs takes clean water free from contamination.

Most of the male pigs are castrated in order to maintain good breads, enhance quick growth of our pigs and reduce on expenses incurred on feeds and treatment.

Use of macro mix with has balanced nutrients for the growth of pigs and we also use locally mixed feed to reduce on expenses.

We also use animal waste products to fertilize our plantation and maximize crop production.

Launch

GOATS DEMONSTRATION SITE

We started with a few goats of local bread which would not grow faster, then we asked the minister to provide us with an improved bread of goats were we got supplied with one male and female goats which were cross bread at 75%, we are now crossing the available bread with the male of 90% cross bread.

Cross bread goats grow faster and most of them delivery more than one goat which helps to quickly increase the stock size.

These cross bread goats eat for a short time and are less disturbing compared to our local breads. They also require monthly treatment and spray. The structure for these goats should be built on a raised mound for quick drainage of excreta.

We sold most of the local breads and remained with a few for comparison in terms growth rates and multiplication for our demonstration.

FISHERIES DEMONSTRATION SITE.

Our pond construction programme started in 2017 and we stocked in fish in November a total of 4400 fish which were put in a happar and we released 3970 to the pond, this reduction in number of fish was due to different factors.

More 2 ponds have been constructed and ready to be stocked, in that regard we are going to stock in different species of fish for comparison however a fence is needed to protect the fish pond from thieves, poisoning and unnecessary movements around the pond.

WATER AND SANITATION

We realized that all these projects would require use water, this prompted us to get underground water which costed us so much due to underground stones, but later we managed to get water in a 300 meters distance using a submersive pump which delivers it into a 30000ltrs tank, from which it collected to the taps for domestic use and selling.

SACCO

We have mobilized people to start up a SACCO in order to improve their projects using affordable loans at 5% interest from the SACCO and many people have benefited from this project.

Future plans for the organization

1. Expansion of the health facility and equipping it with more diagnostic machines to improve the quality of service for the community.
2. We intend to set up pork processing and parking factory and we produce other products like sausage, jelly, cooking oils and making manure from the pigs excreta.
3. We are planning to set up an organic banana plantation using our local fertilizers (animal wastes) in the process of conserving our environment.

4. We are planning to begin giving out piglets to community individuals that have embraced imo structures at their homes; the program is being designed for that activity.
5. We are planning to use machinery in land preparation planting, harvesting, processing, parking and exporting of our agricultural products.

CHALLENGES

1. Lack of enough funds to improve the demonstration site up to the required standards.
2. Lack of fences around the demonstration site to protect them from thieves, infections and unnecessary entries.
3. Lack of finances to procure more fish for the remaining two ponds.
4. Need for other breeds of Pigs, Goats and cattle to improve our demonstration site.
5. The organization needs a vehicle that will help in transportation of our harvests, manure and other materials.
6. Lack of a grain miller for processing animal feeds which has increased on organizations' expenditure.
7. Poor road network
8. Unpredictable climate which has led to destruction of crops.
9. Unnecessary mechanical breakdown of the water pump which creates crisis of water supply in the organization project.

WE REQUEST FOR SUPPORT IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS

1. To recognize us as a fully functioning organization that is promoting community development programs.
2. To provide us with more skills and knowledge in setting up a good demonstration site.
3. As we increase in standards, we request the government to use our demonstration site as a teaching site in Kibaale District as it is strategically located along the Mubende – Kibaale - Kagadi Road and using qualified Doctors and most recent technology in fertilization, structures and crop production.
The demonstration site is unique as it operates different departments under one umbrella organization so that a farmer gets all skills in one place.
4. We have prepared one acre of land ready to plant in tissue banana and it's our request for the government to supply us with those tissue seedlings.
5. We also request the Government to support us with all the above missing equipments for the organization to offer quality services.

6. We request the government to provide BCDO with improved breeds of pigs, goats, cattle, and poultry.
